HUGHS HAVEN

Hugh's Haven is a nursery, pre-school and aftercare facility for about 90 children who all come from financially and socially disadvantaged backgrounds.

After a first visit to Hugh's Haven we took a decision to upgrade the existing facilities by undertaking much needed improvements to the premises. We erected a new FSM facility to provide additional accommodation and storage areas. We then set about casting new floors, replacing window frames and glazing, fitting burglar bars, fixed the plumbing and tiles, and repainted the facility. Finally we installed Astro Turf synthetic turf in the children's playground areas

We also arranged various events for the children including Xmas parties in 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013. We also staged fundraising events to provide the children with much needed foodstuffs, mattresses and clothing.



ST. PATRICKS MOTHER TERESA GROUP

Run on a voluntary basis the Mother Teresa Charity Group’s purpose is to assist the needy with food, clothing and blankets. Volunteers help with both the cooking of meals and the distribution of goods to around 600 people on the streets, and around 49 destitute families on every Tuesday night of the year.

Additional drives included Mandela Day 2014 with donations from Tiber Construction towards the costs of the soup, and supplying 500 blankets and beanies. Volunteers from Tiber Construction also assisted in the preparation of meals and the distribution of blankets to the needy.

During Easter 2015 and Christmas 2015 we also donated monies towards food and toiletries, and helped with the hand out of goods.



CHOC Childhood Cancer Foundation South Africa

The vision of CHOC is to make a difference in the lives of children with cancer and life-threatening blood disorders, and their families.

Through a multitude of programmes CHOC engages with key stakeholders in medical, corporate and government to plan for, develop, and fund hope giving solutions and support to these children and their families.

The newly completed state-of-the-art ward and oncology unit at Charlotte Maxeke Johannesburg Academic Hospital provides a child-friendly place for young patients.

Tiber Construction provided the project management and site supervision, and funded the contract insurances and site running costs.



Nazareth House, Johannesburg

Established in 1894 Nazareth House in Johannesburg provides 24hour care to HIV positive abandoned babies and children up to the age of 10.

St Basil's Hospice at Nazareth House provides facilities for 22 terminally ill adult patients living with HIV/AIDS. Nazareth House also provides care for a 125 frail aged and 10 destitute mentally challenged women.

In addition to pledging R67 000 to Nazareth House on Mandela Day 2013, Tiber Construction also personally donated bags of clothing, foods parcels, and gift packs of sweets to pensioners.

At the 2013 Xmas party we provided gifts for the pensioners and kids and entertainment including an animal show.



Joshua House

Joshua House provides a temporary place of safe care for orphaned, abandoned or legally relinquished babies aged between 0 to 2 years on a short-term basis of 6 to 12 months, pending the legal and medical assessment process to find the best placement option for the child.

Tiber Construction, with the generous assistance from their sub-contractors, assisted Joshua House not only with the development of additional office space, play area and storage facility, but also helped to revamp the main house and property. The upgrades included a new boundary wall, a paved driveway, landscaping of the garden and improved security.
